

## 2007 ELECTION CYCLE CALENDAR OF REPORTING DATES (Municipal Candidates and Municipal Political Committees)

### Filing Campaign Treasurer's Reports

Section 106.07(1), F.S. – Reports shall be filed on the 10<sup>th</sup> day following the end of each calendar quarter from the time the campaign treasurer is appointed. Following the last day of qualifying for office, reports shall be filed on the 32<sup>nd</sup>, 18<sup>th</sup>, and 4<sup>th</sup> days immediately preceding the primary election and on the 18<sup>th</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> days immediately preceding the general election.

### Waiver of Report

Section 106.07(7), F.S. – In any reporting period when there has been no activity in the account (no funds expended or received) the filing of the required report may be waived by notifying the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that no report is being filed.

### 90-Day Termination Report

Candidates Only – Each candidate shall, within 90 days after having become unopposed, withdrawn his/her candidacy, been eliminated or elected to office, dispose of funds in his/her campaign account and file a final report. Refer to section 106.141, F.S., Disposition of surplus funds by candidates.

### Deadline for Filing

Reports shall be filed no later than 5:00 p.m. on the day designated. Any report postmarked by the U.S. Postal Service no later than midnight of the day designated shall be deemed to have been filed in a timely manner. A certificate of mailing obtained from and dated by the U.S. Postal Service at the time of mailing, or receipt from an established courier service, that bears a date on or before the date on which the report is due, shall be proof of mailing in a timely manner.

### Penalty for Late Filing

Any candidate or political committee failing to file a report on the designated due date shall be subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first 3 days late and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25 percent of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for the reports immediately preceding the primary and general elections, the fine shall be \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25 percent of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

### Filing Officer

All reports of a candidate shall be filed with the officer before whom the candidate is required by law to qualify. Municipal candidates file with their City Clerk.

Political committee reports shall be filed with the agency or officer before whom such committee registers.
