Excerpt from the Land Development Code
Ordinance No. 01-136

- (c) **Campaign Signs:** Signs on behalf of candidates for public office or measures on election ballots shall be permitted in any district subject to the following regulations:
1. Signs shall be erected no earlier than 60 days prior to the election and shall be removed within 14 days following the election.
 2. In any residential district, only one stationary sign shall be permitted on any parcel of land and shall not exceed 12 square feet in aggregate area and, if detached, shall not exceed six feet in height.
 3. **No signs shall be erected on public property or right-of-way.**
 4. Prior to the erection of any sign, a \$250.00 cash bond shall be posted by the candidate or committee wishing to erect the same. The obligation of the bond shall be in compliance with this regulation, including removal of signs and all other applicable provisions. The bond shall be used for removal of signs in violation of this regulation at the rate of \$5.00 per sign.
 5. Also, a \$10.00 minimum sign permit fee is required, for a total cash bond and fee of \$260.00
