All reports of a Candidate shall be filed with the City Clerk, The City of Daytona Beach, 301 South Ridgewood Avenue, Daytona Beach, Florida 32114, Room 210, 386-671-8023.

Deposit of Contributions (Section 106.05, F.S.) - All funds received by the campaign treasurer of any candidate shall be deposited in the campaign account prior to the end of the fifth (5th) business day following the receipt thereof (Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays excluded). All deposits must be accompanied by a bank deposit slip containing the name of each contributor and the amount contributed by each.

Deadline for Filing - Reports shall be filed no later than 5:00 p.m. on the day designated. Any report postmarked by the U.S. Postal Service no later than midnight of the day designated shall be deemed to have been filed in a timely manner. A certificate of mailing obtained from and dated by the U.S. Postal Service at the time of mailing, or receipt from an established courier service that bears a date on or before the date on which the report is due, shall be proof of mailing in a timely manner.

Penalty for Late Filing - Any candidate or political committee failing to file a report on the designated due date shall be subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first 3 days late and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25 percent of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for the reports immediately preceding the primary and general elections, the fine shall be \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25 percent of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

Waiver of report - Section 106.07(7), F.S. – In any reporting period when there has been no activity in the account (no funds expended or received) the filing of the required report may be waived by notifying the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that no report is being filed.

90-Day Termination Reports (Section 106.141, F.S.) – Each Candidate shall within 90 days after having become unopposed, withdrawn his/her candidacy, been eliminated or elected to office, dispose of funds in his/her campaign account and file a final report. Final Disposition of funds on deposits in the campaign account for all candidates eliminated or unopposed at qualifying (November 7, 2008) – Reports are due February 5, 2009, 5:00 p.m.

Final Disposition of funds on deposits in the campaign account for all candidates eliminated or elected in Municipal Primary Election (December 16, 2008) – Reports are due by March 16, 2009, 5:00 p.m.

Final Disposition of funds on deposits in the campaign account for all candidates opposed in the Municipal General Election – Reports are due by April 13, 2009, 5:00 p.m.

If a candidate receives a refund check after all surplus funds have been disposed of, the candidate can endorse the check and the refund disposed of as provided by law. An amended report must be filed showing the refund and subsequent disposition.

Candidates qualifying dates are:

Monday, November 3, 2008, 9:00 a.m. – Friday, November 7, 2008, 12:00 noon.
