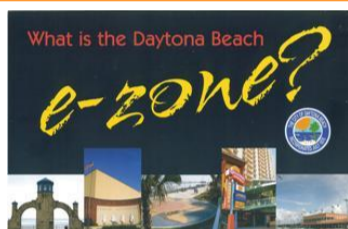
TONIGHT'S HOLIDAY PARADE AND FESTIVITIES RESCHEDULED
