### **ARMED ROBBERY – 1104 BEVILLE ROAD (SUBWAY)**

**Case # - 20100000542**

On 1-9-10, at approximately 2058 hrs, an Armed Robbery occurred at 1104 Beville Road (Subway). A black male suspect entered the business and approached the counter, producing a silver/black colored semi-auto handgun. The suspect demanded the employee put the money from the register into a bag that the suspect brought with him. The suspect then exited the business with an undetermined amount of cash and was last seen westbound from the business on an unknown type of bicycle. The suspect is described as a black male, approximately 6'1", med – heavy build, dark complexion, mustache and gold teeth on the bottom. The suspect was described as wearing dark pants and a gray/black hooded jacket with a distinctive design on the right side of the hood. Investigation revealed the suspect had been in the business twice prior to the Robbery and had obtained and filled out an application. The name and information the suspect used on the application appears to be false information at this time. According to the employees, the suspect wore gloves and the hood up on the jacket each time he was in the business.
