

## **MLK Streetscape work underway after Hurricane Dorian**

*Area receives no major damage*

### **Updates:**

Crews on the Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. streetscape are working on the sanitary sewer structure, beginning with dewatering the intersection of Magnolia Avenue and MLK in order to set the first manhole and begin installation of the new sanitary sewer system. The sanitary sewer work will progress from Magnolia Avenue south to Orange Avenue.

All businesses along MLK are accessible to pedestrians. Pedestrians should not walk through the work area. If walking around the work site perimeter, pedestrians are urged to use caution.

Local traffic is permitted from Orange Avenue north to the work zone and from International Speedway Blvd. south to the work zone. All through traffic is being routed around the area via Orange Avenue, Segrave Street, Lockhart Street and International Speedway Blvd.

All businesses along MLK are accessible to pedestrians. Pedestrians should not walk through the work area. If walking around the work site perimeter, pedestrians are urged to use caution.

### **Project Overview:**

The \$2.6 million project will completely reconstruct the road's surface, update underground utilities, widen sidewalks, install decorative lighting features and landscaping and add on-street parking on the east side of the roadway.
