

MLK Streetscape continues

Updates:

Crews are completing the sanitary sewer pipe run from Magnolia Ave. to Eldorado St. and weather permitting, installing the sanitary sewer manhole at the MLK and Eldorado intersection this week. Work will continue in the Magnolia intersection to secure an old repurposed reuse pipe. Each parcel along the MLK corridor will be getting a new sewer lateral, water service and reclaim water service. FPL transferred power to the new poles last week.

All businesses along MLK are accessible to pedestrians. Pedestrians should not walk through the work area. If walking around the work site perimeter, pedestrians are urged to use caution. Local traffic is permitted from Orange Avenue north to the work zone and from International Speedway Blvd. south to the work zone. All through traffic is being routed around the area via Orange Avenue, Segrave Street, Lockhart Street and International Speedway Blvd.

Project Overview:

The \$2.6 million project will completely reconstruct the road's surface, update underground utilities, widen sidewalks, install decorative lighting features and landscaping and add on-street parking on the east side of the roadway.
