

Crews work to restore roadway south of Magnolia Avenue; work north toward ISB begins Dec. 2

Updates:

Crews have finished installing all of the sanitary sewer, potable water main and reclaim water main between Magnolia Avenue and Orange Avenue. They are pressure testing the potable and reclaim mains, and then will finish backfilling and compacting the trenches and roadbed in preparation of restoring the roadway south of Magnolia Avenue. Crews plan to begin the replacement work of the sidewalks and curbing from Magnolia Avenue to Orange Avenue after the Thanksgiving holiday.

While crews are working to restore the roadway south of Magnolia Avenue (Phase II work), the water main crew will move on to the next section of the project, which is from the MLK and Magnolia Avenue intersection to International Speedway Boulevard (Phase III). Beginning Monday, Dec. 2, crews will begin installing the new water main from Magnolia Avenue north to International Speedway Boulevard. When they begin this work, the road will not be completely closed. They will have a one-lane flagging operation during business hours on this north portion of MLK, and at the Magnolia Avenue and MLK intersection, and the road will be open after business hours.

All businesses along MLK are accessible to pedestrians. The area has signage for the detours around the area, as well as signs for the businesses. Businesses are accessible through the side streets around the area. Customers of businesses in the area can park temporarily in the right-of-way on the side streets. Pedestrians should not walk through the work area. If walking around the work site perimeter, pedestrians are urged to use caution.
