

Crews continues to make progress on MLK Road Project

Updates:

Crews are continuing with the sidewalk replacement and curbing from Magnolia Avenue to Orange Avenue. There will be intermittent Saturday work in the coming weeks.

Crews are also continuing to prepare the roadway base south of Magnolia Avenue. A one-lane flagging operation is continuing on the north portion of MLK, from Magnolia Avenue to ISB, which allows the crews to work on the installation of the new water main in this area. The road on this north portion remains open after business hours.

Also this week, Daytona Beach City Manager Jim Chisholm and Public Works officials met with property owners in the area to get project feedback and address issues. As the project continues, staff are resolving concerns with the businesses to help ensure they understand project details and that impacts to their businesses are mitigated.

All businesses along MLK are accessible to pedestrians. The area has signage for the detours around the area, as well as signs for the businesses. Customers of businesses in the area can park temporarily in the right-of-way on the side streets. Pedestrians should not walk through the work area. If walking around the work site perimeter, pedestrians are urged to use caution.
