

**Crews start pouring
curbing and sidewalk
on west side of MLK**

Removal of outdated underground utilities continues

Crews plan to start pouring concrete for the curbing and sidewalk on the west side of MLK between Orange Avenue and Magnolia Avenue beginning next week. The new water main has been connected, and customers are in the process of being connected to the system in this section of MLK. Crews will be removing the old water line in this area next week.

The Magnolia Avenue and MLK intersection has been reopened to local traffic only, as crews have successfully connected the water main to the new lines installed going south on MLK.

The work from Magnolia Avenue to ISB continues as crews remove the existing 12-inch clay gravity sewer, and install sewer laterals and reclaim pipes. In coordination with the work, city utilities staff are making spot repairs to the system. To facilitate this additional work, city staff are taking 8-hour days and turning them into 12-hour days to expedite the repairs and minimize any impact to businesses.

Businesses on MLK remain open as road improvements continue between Orange Avenue and International Speedway Boulevard. The area has detour signage, as well as signs for all businesses in the area. Customers can park temporarily in the right-of-way on the side streets to access the businesses. Pedestrians should not walk through the work area.
