

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-286

A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY DUE TO COVID-19 FOR AN ADDITIONAL SEVEN DAY PERIOD ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2020; RATIFYING MAYORAL EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 16; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in response to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (“COVID-19”), Governor Ron DeSantis declared a public health emergency in the State of Florida by his Executive Order No. 20-51; and

WHEREAS, consistent with the City's Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan, adopted pursuant to Ch. 252, Fla. Stat., and City Resolution No. 19-131, the Mayor of The City of Daytona Beach, Derrick L. Henry, issued a Declaration of a Local State of Emergency due to COVID-19 on March 13, 2020, and an Amended Declaration of a Local State of Emergency and Executive Order on March 17, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has affirmed, endorsed, and extended the Local State of Emergency for successive additional seven day periods, most recently by Resolution No. 2020-254, which extended the Local State of Emergency through September 16, 2020; and

WHEREAS, Mayor Henry has issued Executive Order No. 16, further extending the Local State of Emergency for an additional seven day period ending on September 23, 2020; and

WHEREAS, a further extension of the Local State of Emergency is necessary to protect the health and welfare of citizens due to COVID-19, and the Mayor and City Commission desire to extend the Local State of Emergency for an additional seven day period through September 30, 2020.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DAYTONA BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The Local State of Emergency as described in the recitals above is hereby reaffirmed, endorsed, and extended through 11:59 p.m. on September 30, 2020, unless sooner terminated or extended by order of the Mayor or action of City Commission.


SECTION 2. The City Commission hereby ratifies the Mayoral Executive Order No. 16, extending the local state of emergency due to COVID-19 as described in the recitals.

SECTION 3. During the Local State of Emergency, emergency measures may be exercised as set forth in Section 2-3, City Code, and the Mayor shall have authority to execute executive orders as necessary to aid in their appropriate implementation.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
