To help protect your public sewer system, clean waters and to effectively manage the amount of fats, oils and grease that is discharged from food service establishments, the City of Daytona Beach has partnered with FOG BMP to support their Fats, Oils and Grease Management Control Program.

As a FOG generator, your cooperation with this program will have enormous positive effects not only within your facility but also downstream in the public sewer, wastewater treatment plant and the clean waters they discharge into.

Properly handling fats, oils and grease within your facility will eliminate grease build up in your drain lines therefore greatly reducing the need for unwanted costs associated with drain cleaning.

Routine cleaning of your grease trap will ensure FOG doesn't pass through and enter the public sewer system resulting in sewer system overflows.

FOG BMP is an online management tool that connects your facility and your waste hauler with the City of Daytona Beach. This enables them to ensure that all FOG generating facilities and waste haulers within their jurisdiction are properly handling and managing FOG according to their regulations.

FOG BMP provides a simple, user-friendly platform, with all the tools necessary for you and your waste hauler to work with the City of Daytona Beach to reach their goals.

Once you have received your permit from the City of Daytona Beach you will receive an email invitation from our server to login to FOGBMP. Simply click on the link and follow the instructions to setup your facility.
